Romans 1:11 (KJV) For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established;

Impartation is the spiritual transfer that takes place through relationship. Impartation has the power to accelerate your spiritual growth and to help lay a foundation for the future of your ministry. When you open yourself to the teachings of or relationship with an anointed individual, you become a recipient of impartation. A portion of what is on their life begins to rub off onto you.

Impartation does not just take place between a mentor and a disciple. It can occur between two spiritual peers. Impartation makes you a unique expression of God's power. As you draw impartation from an anointed man of God, you become a unique individual and uncommonly blended with the anointing. There is a big difference between impartation and imitation. You are not the next anyone, you are the first you. Impartation accelerates your spiritual growth, as you learn by the Spirit from those who have gone ahead of you and accessed great doors and keys of the kingdom.

PRAYER POINTS:

- Pray thanking God for the ministry of the Holy Spirit upon your life.
- Pray that you will be able to submit and learn from those who have gone ahead of you.

DECLARATIONS:

- I declare the ability for outstanding and excellent performance by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- I declare supernatural speed and undeniable growth in your life in Jesus name.

The word of God says Jesus instructed the man to take up his mat and walk. Be a believer that walks with faith and steps out of comfortable common environments.

Relationships are strategic alliances that play a critical role in achieving your mission and vision. It is therefore important to understand the timeline of each relationship you can ever find yourself in. There are short-term relationships and long-term ones, all with the objective of propelling you towards your destiny. Your relationship with God or marriage are examples of lifetime relationships.

Mephibosheth in the opening scripture became a beneficiary of the lifetime relationship between his father Jonathan and David. Every good and properly managed relationship will produce mutual benefits. Whatever type of relationship you are in, make sure you correctly manage it and get the rewards intended for you.

PRAYER POINTS:

- Pray for the knowledge needed to preserve and manage connections so that you do not lose relationships that are important for your destiny.
- Pray for the capacity to accept the end of certain relationships and the bravery to move on.

DECLARATION:

- I declare that you will be able to maintain relationships in your life and hold on to connections that are meant to last longer.
- I declare that you will be able to transition from short-term relationships without feeling obliged to hold on.

The main scripture is revealing that every person is a product their association. However, when you associate yourself with individuals who are foolish and lack good judgment, you open up yourself to negative influences that can lead you down a destructive path.

Be very intentional on who to keep in your inner circle. Always remember, iron sharpens iron.

Ecclesiastes 5:10 (NLT) Those who love money will never have enough. How meaningless to think that wealth brings true happiness!

The spirituality of money is found within ourselves, in the skills and abilities that God has bestowed upon us. Many people remain impoverished because they look for money in the wrong places.
